1. Scope & Applicability:

This policy applies to:

- All personal data collected by Quantamatik Consulting LLP through its website, services, and business activities in India or related to individuals in India;
- All categories of data principals (clients, vendors, employees, job applicants, website visitors, etc.);
- Data processed during global operations with safeguards for cross-border data transfers.

2. Definitions:

- **Personal Data**: Any information about an individual who can be identified by or relates to such data.
- **Sensitive Personal Data (SPD)**: Includes financial, biometric, health, sexual orientation, caste, or religious beliefs (processed only with explicit consent).
- Data Principal: The person whose data is being processed.
- Data Fiduciary: Quantamatik Consulting LLP.
- Processing: Collection, storage, use, disclosure, transfer, or erasure of personal data.
- Consent Manager: A registered entity (if used) that allows data principals to give and manage consent.

3. What Personal Data We Collect:

We may collect these types of personal data:

Identity Data	Name, contact number, email address, IP addresses.
Employment Data	CVs, educational background, experience, job preferences.
Client/Business Data	Company name, designation, contact details.
Technical Data	Browser, OS, device type, cookies, IP addresses.
Usage Data	Pages visited, time spent, clicks, session logs.
Sensitive Data (if any)	Biometric, health, or financial data (with explicit consent).

4. How We Collect Data:

We gather personal data:

- **Directly from you** when you fill out forms, submit applications, or communicate with us;
- Automatically via cookies, analytics tools, or logging technologies on our website;
- **From third parties** such as recruiters, job portals, service partners, or public sources.



5. Legal Basis for Processing:

We process your data on the following grounds:

- Consent for marketing, job applications, sensitive data, or optional features;
- **Legitimate use** for client engagement, employee management, IT operations;
- Contractual Necessity for fulfilling our service agreements;
- **Legal Obligations** where required under tax, regulatory, or judicial laws.

6. Purpose of Processing:

We use your data for:

- Providing IT consulting and development services;
- Managing recruitment, hiring, and the employee lifecycle;
- Enhancing user experience and website performance;
- Sending communications and service updates;
- Conducting analytics, audits, and internal reports;
- Meeting legal, regulatory, or compliance requirements;
- Ensuring information security and preventing fraud.

7. Consent & Withdrawal:

We obtain **freely given, specific, informed, and revocable consent** for collecting and processing personal data where required.

You can withdraw consent at any time by contacting us or through a registered Consent Manager (if applicable). Once you cancel, we will stop processing your data unless we are legally or contractually required to do so.



8. Data Sharing & Disclosures:

We may share your data with:

- Authorised personnel within Quantamatik Consulting LLP on a need-to-know basis;
- Vendors, service providers, and partners (e.g., cloud hosting, payroll processors, analytics);
- Legal or regulatory authorities, when mandated by law;
- Successor entities in the event of a merger, acquisition, or restructuring.

Note: We do not sell personal data under any circumstances. This principle is central to our data practices, ensuring your personal information is always respected and not used for commercial purposes.

9. Cross-Border Data Transfers:

When we transfer data outside India (such as to cloud services or international clients), we ensure:

- Transfers only to countries approved by the Indian Government, or
- Binding contractual clauses that ensure data protection comparable to Indian standards.

10. Data Retention:

We retain personal data only as long as necessary for the purpose it was collected or as legally required.

Job Applicant Data	24 months or until consent is withdrawn.
Client Data	Contract term + statutory period (up to 7
	years).
Employee Records	As per Indian labour/tax regulations.
Marketing / Cookie Data	Up to 12 months or until user opts out.

11. Rights of Data Principals:

As per the DPDP Act, you have the right to:

- Access your data;
- Correction of outdated or incorrect data.
- Erasure of data no longer necessary (subject to legal exceptions);
- Nominate a representative to exercise rights if incapacity occurs.
- Withdraw your consent at any time.

12. Security Measures:

We implement appropriate administrative, technical, and organizational measures:

- Data encryption during transfer (TLS/SSL) and storage (where applicable).

- Regular audits, firewalls, and intrusion prevention systems.
- Incident response protocols for breach notification.
